WTC Site Wide Property Management - Authorization of 2015 Funding

Background

Objectives

- Maintain a Class-A standard and enhance the customer/visitor experience at the World Trade Center
- Increase value to PA and its business partners by operating a world-class complex

Prior Authorizations

- May 2013: Board authorized Property Management Agreement with Cushman & Wakefield to provide long-term management, operation, & maintenance of the WTC site
 - 7 year term (w/ 3 one-year options)
 - Management Fee of up to \$5.5M for the base term with up to 20% of such amount subject to quarterly performance review
 - Payment of \$9.1M for management/oversight staff, operations/maintenance staff, & contract services for initial year with future years payments subject to further authorizations
- May 2014: Board authorized additional funding under the existing World Trade Center site wide property management services contract for site-wide facilities
 - 6 month term (July 31, 2014 – December 31, 2014)
 - Payment of Management Fee of \$425,000
 - Payment of \$11.1M for management/oversight staff, operations/maintenance staff, & contract services

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Assets Under Management

2015 will be a transitional year as large portions of the site transition from construction to operations


