

2009 M/W/SBE AWARDS BY SOURCE



2009 TOTAL REGIONAL IMPACTS

The regional economic impact estimates of the total \$358 million in contract awards to M/W/SBEs:

- Created 3,070 jobs in the region
- Generated more than \$165 million in wages
- Produced \$581 million in regional economic activity

REGIONAL ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF CONSTRUCTION AWARDS

The regional economic impact estimates of the total \$280 million in construction contract awards to M/W/SBEs:

- Supported 2,120 jobs in the region
- Generated approximately \$125 million in wages
- Produced \$482 million in regional economic activity

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMS

- 14 M/WBEs participated in the Mentor-Protégé Program in 2009
- 35 MWBEs have participated in the program since its inception in 2002
- Seven protégés successfully bid on 11 Port Authority contracts totaling approximately \$5.7 million
- A new initiative designed for firms grossing under \$500K annually was implemented with six participant firms

- Mandatory 10-hour OSHA Certificate Program for field staff in New York
