Goethals Bridge Replacement Project

- April 2013-Board Authorized \$1.5 billion project to replace the Goethals Bridge and to award a Public-Private Partnership (P3) contract to NYNJ Link Developer
- First time in 80-plus years agency will construct a new long span bridge
- First Port Authority cable stayed bridge
- First true surface transportation P3 in the Northeast

Goethals Bridge Replacement Project

Existing Functionally Obsolete

- Four 10 ft Lanes
- No Shoulders
- No Walkway



New Replacement Bridge

- Six 12 ft Lanes with shoulders
- State-of-the-art Cable Stayed Design
- Up-to-date safety and security features
- Pedestrian/Bicycle Access
- Accommodation for future mass transit
- Innovative Bridge Technology
