RE: Request for Records Regarding Vehicle and Accident

Dear Freedom of Information Officer:

Pursuant to the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey's ("the Port Authority") Freedom of Information Policy and Procedure ("FOI Procedure"), I write to request access to and electronic copies of the following documents:

1. Any and all documents pertaining to maintenance, compliance, inspection, inspection receipts, repair, and vehicle registration of Delta Airlines Inc. ("Delta") vehicle with former PANYNJ Plate number A01756, which is believed to be subsequently replaced with A14227 on January 04, 2011. The owner/operator of the vehicle is Delta, with Delta numbering the vehicle 49671, with vin number 1FCJE39H7LHB79580. The Reg/Insp Sticker number is K00106.
2. Any and all documents, including but not limited to, the Motor Vehicle Crash Report and inspection receipts, for an accident that occurred at John F. Kennedy International Airport rampside of terminal #2, gate 24, spot 6 on January 03, 2011. The motor vehicle crash number is 179. The accident involved the aforementioned vehicle bearing former PANYNJ plate number A01756, which as of January 04, 2011 is believed to have been replaced with A14227.

3. Any and all documents, including but not limited to, the Motors Vehicle Crash Report and inspection receipts, for any incidents or accidents involving a Delta vehicle bearing the former PANYNJ plate number A01756, which is believed to have been replaced with A14227 on January 04, 2011.
4. Any and all documents regarding Delta's compliance with Port Authority requirements for the inspection and routine maintenance of Delta vehicle bearing former PANYNJ plate number A01756, which is believed to have been replaced with A14227 on January 04, 2011.

Pursuant to the Port Authority's FOI Procedure, we hope to receive a response to this request within five business days of receipt thereof by granting access, denying access or acknowledging receipt of the request and providing a date that is within twenty days from the initial response on which the Port Authority shall grant or deny the request.

Should the Secretary determine that any of the above requested records are exempt from disclosure, I request that the Secretary identify specifically which categories are exempted. Further, should the Secretary determine that any of the above requests are so overly broad as to make it impracticable for the Secretary to identify such records, please indicate specifically which request so that we may work cooperatively in resolving the issue.
