Virginia S. Bauer

Virginia S. Bauer was appointed to the Board of Commissioners in June 2007 by Governor Corzine. Ms. Bauer is currently the Chief Executive Officer of Gold-Type Business Machines, Inc. (GTBM) a security technologies firm. Previously, Ms. Bauer was the Senior Vice President of Development at the Covenant House in New York City, the nation's largest adolescent care agency serving homeless, runaway and at-risk youth. Ms. Bauer served as CEO and Secretary of the New Jersey Commerce, Economic Growth & Tourism Commission from December 2004 to July 2007. She also served from 2005-2008 as Vice Chairperson of the Fort Monmouth Economic Redevelopment Authority, leading the state's effort to develop a revitalization plan for the 1,600-acre military facility. Ms. Bauer is the former Director of the New Jersey Lottery, where under her leadership, the agency achieved a \$2.2 billion sales year in Fiscal 2004, the Lottery's best sales year ever. Ms. Bauer is a former financial planning and account management executive with Merrill Lynch from 1979-1985.

Ms. Bauer, a widow of a New Jersey victim of the September 11, 2001 attack on the World Trade Center, has been a key activist on behalf of the families of the 9/11 victims, after her husband David, a Cantor Fitzgerald employee, was killed in the World Trade Center.

Henry R. Silverman

Henry R. Silverman was appointed to the Board of Commissioners in June 2002 by Governor Pataki. He served as Vice-Chairman of the agency from May 24, 2007 to May 18, 2010. Currently, Mr. Silverman is Vice Chairman of Apollo Global Management, a leading alternative asset manager, which he joined in 2007.

Prior to Apollo, for 17 years Mr. Silverman served as Chairman and CEO of Cendant Corporation and its predecessor and successor. Cendant was a "Fortune 100" company and the largest global provider of consumer and business services within the travel and residential real estate sectors prior to its separation into several new companies in late 2006. He continues to serve as Chairman of Realogy Corporation, formerly Cendant's real estate division.

Mr. Silverman is a trustee of New York University School of Medicine and Medical Center. Mr. Silverman has long been involved with numerous philanthropic, public service and social policy initiatives. He is a former trustee of the Whitney Museum of American Art, the Dance Theatre of Harlem, the University of Pennsylvania, Penn Medicine, New York University and the NYU Child Study Center. He is also a former member of the Business Roundtable and the G-100.

Mr. Silverman's philanthropy includes Silverman Hall, the Silverman-Rodin scholars and the Silverman Professor of Law at Penn Law School, and the Silverman Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at NYU School of Medicine. Mr. Silverman is a graduate of Williams College and the University of Pennsylvania Law School.

Stanley E. Grayson

Stanley E. Grayson was appointed to the Board of Commissioners in December 2008 by Governor Paterson. He was elected Vice-Chairman of the agency on May 18, 2010. Mr. Grayson is the Vice Chairman and Chief Operating Officer of M. R. Beal & Company, an African American owned investment banking firm specializing in the structuring, underwriting and selling of municipal bonds and notes along with fixed income and equity securities, trading and financial advisory services to state and local governments, public authorities, non-profits and corporations throughout the United States.

Prior to joining M. R. Beal & Company, Mr. Grayson was the Managing Director and Manager of the Public Finance Department of Prudential Securities Incorporated and member of the firm's Operating Council. From 1990 through 1996, Mr. Grayson was a Vice President at Goldman, Sachs & Co. in the Municipal Bond Department's Infrastructure and General Banking Group.

Immediately preceding his investment-banking career, Mr. Grayson served as Deputy Mayor for Finance and Economic Development for the City of New York. As Deputy Mayor, Mr. Grayson was responsible for formulating and guiding the City's policies to expand economic activity, retain and create jobs, attract new businesses, increase the local tax base, and maintain and improve the City's business climate and condition. As Deputy Mayor, he oversaw the City's Finance Department, Department of Employment and four economic development agencies: The Office of Business Development, The Department of Ports and Trade, The Public Development Corporation, and The Financial Services Corporation.

Previously, Mr. Grayson served as the City's Finance Commissioner. From December 1984 through December 1987, he served as Commissioner and Chairman of Financial Services Corporation – a not-for-profit organization and predecessor agency to the City's Economic Development Corporation. Mr. Grayson also served at that time as Chairman of the City's Industrial Development Agency. Prior to serving in the administration of Former Mayor Edward J. Koch, Mr. Grayson was a member of the Law Department of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company in New York City, where he specialized in the areas of corporate finance and securities investments.

Mr. Grayson received his law degree from The University of Michigan Law School and his Bachelor of Arts from The College of the Holy Cross. He is a retired member of the New York State Bar, and serves on the Board of Directors of TD Bank, N.J., New York Catholic Charities, The Alliance for Downtown Business, The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (MSRB) and the New York State Small Business Advisory Board.

Anthony R. Coscia



Anthony R. Coscia was appointed Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey in April 2003. He spearheaded the agency's adoption of a \$29.5 billion ten year capital plan, which provides for substantial expansion of the region's transportation facilities, including development of a new trans-Hudson rail tunnel, expanded aviation facilities and rebuilding of the World Trade Center Site.

He has specific experience in the area of corporate, financial and real estate transactions. From February 1992 to March 2003, Mr. Coscia served as Chair of the New Jersey Economic Development Authority. He serves as a trustee of the New Jersey Network Foundation, New Jersey Community Development Corporation and the Liberty Science Center Foundation, and is a member of the Partnership for New York City and the New Jersey Performing Arts Center Council of Trustees. Mr. Coscia is a graduate of the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service and received his law degree from the Rutgers University School of Law. He was awarded an honorary degree in 2007 from the New Jersey Institute of Technology. He has served on the board of public and closely held corporations in the financial services, manufacturing and real estate sectors.

Michael J. Chasanoff was appointed to the Board of Commissioners of The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey by Governor Pataki in April 1999. Mr. Chasanoff served as a Director of the 1995 Special Olympics World Summer Games and The Washington Institute for Near East Policy. He currently serves on the Board of the Cardiovascular Institute of Mount Sinai Medical Center. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Yale College.

Fred P. Hochberg was appointed to the Board of Commissioners in August 2008 by Governor Paterson. Mr. Hochberg became Dean of Milano The New School for Management and Urban Policy in January 2004. Milano is a graduate school that trains leaders for the nonprofit, public, and private sectors with a faculty who blends theory with hands-on practice, and progressive thinking with social commitment. Mr. Hochberg has more than 30 years of experience in business, government, and philanthropy. From 1998 through 2001, he served as deputy then acting administrator of the Small Business Administration (SBA). Prior to joining the Clinton administration, he was president and chief operating officer of the Lillian Vernon Corporation, where he led the transformation of a small family mail order company into a publicly traded direct marketing corporation, one of the great success stories of American entrepreneurship. Mr. Hochberg is dedicated to community service and philanthropic involvement in civil rights, education, and the arts. He currently sits on the boards of directors of the Citizens Budget Commission, FINCA International Micro Finance, Fusion Communications, Seedco, and the Howard Gilman Foundation, and is an appointed representative to the NYS Financial Control Board. 
David S. Mack

Charles A. Gargano



Charles Gargano was appointed by Governor George Pataki in April 1995 as Commissioner of the The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey. From 1995 to January 2007, Mr. Gargano served as Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development and Chairman and CEO of the Empire State Development Corporation. He also served as Chairman of the 42nd Street Development Corporation, Moynihan Station Development Corporation, Convention Center Development Corporation, and several other subsidiaries of Empire State Development. He began his career in public service in 1981 when he was named Deputy Administrator of the Federal Urban Mass Transportation Administration by President Ronald Reagan. In 1988 he was appointed Ambassador to the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by President Reagan, and then was re-appointed in 1989 by President Bush where he served until 1991. Mr. Gargano, a professional engineer, previously has had a successful career as an engineer and principal at J.D. Angelo J. Genova was appointed to the Board by former Governor McGreevey in July 2004. Mr. Genova served as General Counsel to New Jersey Governor Florio's Transition Team in 1989 and as the Governor's Chief Labor Negotiator and Special Labor Advisor from 1991 to 1994. He currently serves as Labor Counsel to the NJ Association of Counties and as Special Counsel on Civil Rights Matters to the NJ League of Municipalities. He serves as Special Labor Counsel to the State of New Jersey and numerous other independent authorities. Mr. Genova also serves on various non-profit and philanthropic boards. Jack Sinagra was appointed to the Board of Commissioners by Acting Governor Donald DiFrancesco in 2001 and served as Chairman of the Board from December 2001 to April 2003. Mr. Sinagra was first elected to the New Jersey State Senate, 18th District, in November of 1991; he was reelected for four-year terms in 1993 and again in 1997. Mr. Sinagra resigned from the Senate in October 2001. In January 1999, William J. Martini was appointed by Governor Christine Todd Whitman to be a Commissioner of The Port Authority of New York & New Jersey.

Martini, former U.S. Congressman for New Jersey's 8th District, is a partner in the law firm of Sills, Cummis, Radin, Tischman, Epstein & Gross of Newark, one of the region's largest. He specializes in complex commercial litigation, administrative law and regulatory affairs.

Upon graduation from law school, Martini clerked for a judge in the Hudson County Superior Court. Following that, he served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of New Jersey, before starting his own practice.

From 1995 to 1997, Martini represented the people of southern Passaic and western Essex Counties in the U.S. House of Representatives, only the first Republican to do so since 1962. During his term in Congress, he authored three bills and set a political strategy that resulted in their passage and being signed into law by the President, a signature achievement for a freshman Member of Congress.

As a member of the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, Martini worked closely with members of the New York and New Jersey congressional delegations on legislation involving mass transit, highways, and other transportation projects for the region as well as the Ports of New York and New Jersey.

During 1990 to 1995, Martini served as a Clifton, New Jersey, City Council member and Passaic County Freeholder, concentrating on fiscal and environmental quality issues.

As Chairman of the Nicholas Martini Foundation, he directs one of North Jersey's leading philanthropic organizations dedicated to supporting educational, health care, cultural and community service groups throughout the region. Through his support of charitable and educational causes, Martini has been the recipient of numerous honors and awards, including Project Children's Humanitarian Award (1994) and Man of the Year from the Passaic Valley Hospice (1993), and Man of the Year from The Center for Italian-American Culture, Inc. (1999).

His extensive civic involvement includes memberships on the boards of Hackensack University Medical Center, and John Cabot University, Rome, Italy, the North Jersey Regional Chamber of Commerce, and is also a member of the National Italian-American Foundation.

Martini is a graduate of Villanova University (BA 1968) and Rutgers University School of Law-Newark (JD 1976). A lifelong Passaic County resident, Martini, his wife, son and daughter, live in Clifton.
