Dear Sir:

This Is a Freedom of Information Request. I want all records concerning the incident below.

On January 20, 2010, I worked as an Airport Security Agent (PA #6440243406) for FJC Security Services at John F. Kennedy Airport, Jamaica, New York. At 4:58 AM, I was in the Avianca Airlines office on the second floor of the cargo building at Terminal 4. I told my supervisor, Alberto Cabanilla (PA #6440273833), that I was going home and walked out the door of the office, west down the hall to the nearest door leading to the stairwell. Mr. Cabanilla followed me out of

the office onto the hall next to the office while talking to some one on the cell phone.

At 4:59 AM, I swiped my Port Authority of New York and New Jersey ID card into the card scanner next to the door and entered my PIN on the numerical keypad next to the door. When I pushed the door open, the alarm went off at B22 (WD2010). Then I swiped my ID card in the card scanner again and re-entered my PIN as before. The door alarm continued to go off as I exited the door. I did not notify Central Security as my supervisor saw me go out the door. The activation was bookmarked (visible on camera 033, 367, and 373 starting at 3:45:31 on camera 033).

The overnight supervisor on duty was Miss Allen (718-244-7322 extension 8). PAPD officer Beaterman and TSA Reg officer Daniel were both advised of the activation. Both said that they did not need to respond as the agent had a valid SIDA badge. Infraction #004596 was issued to the agent.

In addition, at 1 PM that same day, JFC Security Services General Manager, James Donohue, told me that as a result of the single door

alarm going off, all airplane flights were canceled at Terminal 4 and the entire building was cleared.

I want all records concerning this incident.
