If it ended in an arrest, I want a detail of the charges, whether police referred the person to another agency ICE for example and why.

Of those, a full accounting of which of the people the Port Authority arrested or otherwise detained. Copies of the police reports or a spreadsheet that details the names of the people, their addresses, their gender, their race, their date of birth, the date of the incident, a full description of the incident and the result of the referral, whether it resulted in an arrest or in police letting the person go. If it ended in an arrest, a detail of the charges, whether police referred the person to another agency ICE for example and why. The information I am requesting should also explain why TSA requested police assistance. Information about detentions should explain why they were detained and any related searches the police performed during detention.
