**SUBJECT: PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION

Dear Ms. Carter:

1. The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey ("Authority") hereby offers to retain Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. ("the Consultant" or "you") to provide the subject services as more fully set forth in Attachment A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, on an as-needed basis.

2. This Agreement shall be signed by you and the Chief Procurement Officer. As used herein "Chief Engineer" shall mean the Chief Engineer, or the Deputy Chief Engineer, of the Authority, acting either personally or through his duly authorized representatives acting within the scope of the particular authority vested in them unless specifically stated as acting personally.

For the purpose of administering this Agreement, the Chief Engineer has designated Wally Caban, Chief of Construction, to act as his duly authorized representative. 3. Your services shall be performed as expeditiously as possible and at the time or times required by the Chief Engineer. Time is of the essence in the performance of all your services under this Agreement.

4. In order to effectuate the policy of the Authority, the services provided by the Consultant shall comply with all provisions of Federal, State, municipal, local and departmental laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and orders which would affect or control said services as if the services were being performed for a private corporation, unless the Authority standard is more stringent, in which case the Authority standard shall be followed, or unless the Consultant shall receive a written notification to the contrary signed by the Chief Engineer personally, in which case the requirements of said notification shall apply.

5. The Consultant shall meet and consult with Authority staff as requested by the Chief Engineer in connection with the services to be performed herein. Any Contract Drawings and Technical Specifications and other items to be submitted or prepared by the Consultant hereunder shall be subject to the review of the Chief Engineer.

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
