Mr. Mohr,

Thank you for the response and for the information provided. While the file does provide some of the information I requested, it is not fully responsive to my request, as it did not provide the on-time data I was seeking. The on-time information provided in the PDF is in aggregate form. It tallies the number of on-time trains by date. I am seeking data for specific routes -- at the individual route level. I would like the record for each trip, as specified in my original request:

An electronic copy of on-time performance data for all PATH trains -- all trips, all trains, all lines -- from Jan. 1, 2010, through the present. The file should include the date of trip, train ID number, line name, originating terminal, destination terminal, scheduled start time at originating terminal, scheduled arrival time at destination terminal, actual arrival time at destination terminal, on-time/late arrival indicator, and the reason for any delay. I also would like fields indicating if the train was canceled or terminated before reaching its destination, and if so, why. Please also include any notes on each trip that are stored in your database. The most preferable file format would be tab-delimited text (ASCII), delivered electronically or on DVD by mail. Please include code descriptions or lookup tables, preferably in electronic form, for any coded fields.

Also, I need the information in a format other than PDF, preferably ASCII delimited text. A Word or Excel file would work, as well.

I can explain this further by telephone if you would like. Thank you.
