Amounts to be agreed upon for the preparation of working drawings and catalog cuts pursuant to the Section of the Specifications entitled "Shop Drawings, Catalog Cuts and Samples" for working drawings and catalog cuts required by the Engineer for Work to be compensated in accordance with the clause of the Form of Contract entitled "Net Cost".

**27. UNIT PRICES**

The following Schedule of Unit Prices for Classified Work does not constitute an outline of the Work required by the Contract Drawings and Specifications in their present form, but is merely a list of all the items of Classified Work to be used in computing the Contractor's compensation insofar as it is based upon Classified Work, together with the rates at which such compensation will be computed. In the case of each item of Classified Work, the Work performed will be measured and the Contractor's compensation will be computed as hereinafter provided in this numbered clause. In case of discrepancy between the prices quoted in writing and those quoted in figures, the writing shall control.

The estimated quantities are given solely as a basis for the computation of the Total. The Authority makes no representation as to what the actual quantities will be and shall not be held responsible even though the estimated quantities are not even approximately correct. Insofar as the Contractor's compensation is based upon Classified Work, it will be computed from the actual quantities of Work performed, whether greater or less than the estimated quantities.
