Pursuant to our conversation today, and in reference to the above request, under FOIL, I request.

1. Any emails exchanged between David Wildstein and Nicole Crifo on November 19 2013 and November 21, 2013 concerning "Port Authority matters."

2. I also request any emails exchanged between David Wildstein and Nicole Crifo concerning "press strategy" from September 1, 2013 - December 6, 2013.

For your guidance, here are the relevant passages from court documents filed 6/13/16 that reference the emails.

1. "For example, Ms. Crifo was counsel to the Authorities Unit in the OGNJ and helped prepare Mr. Baroni and personally edited Mr. Baroni's intended remarks before the legislative committee, remarks for which Mr. Baroni has been indicted for allegedly providing false testimony. According to the privilege log, Ms. Crifo received an email from David Wildstein on November 19, 2013, the very time Ms. Crifo was assisting in Mr. Baroni's preparation for the legislative hearings, that is described as "Reflecting confidential internal deliberations re: press strategy related to internal Port Authority Matter." Taylor Dec. Ex. A Doc. No. 2343. Similarly, on November 21, 2013, again when Ms. Crifo was participating in Mr. Baroni's preparation, she received another e-mail from Wildstein that is described as "Reflecting confidential internal deliberations re: internal Port Authority matters." Id. Doc. No. 2363. On November 26, 2013, the day after Mr. Baroni's testimony, Ms. Crifo received an e-mail from Mr. Baroni that is described as "Reflecting confidential internal deliberations re: personnel issues." Id. Doc. No. 2395.

2, "The log also indicates that several documents exchanged between OGNJ counsel Nicole Crifo, David Wildstein and William Baroni have been withheld because they "Reflect[] confidential internal deliberation re: press strategy."
