Pursuant to the law of the States of New York and New Jersey, I request the following public records to be provided in accordance with the law:

1. Written and email communications from or to Executive Director Patrick Foye regarding any candidates for the position of Chief Security Officer between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.

To the extent any material requested is alleged to be privileged or barred by provisions of applicable law, please provide the basis for any such claim.

Please be advised that effective June 26, 2015, pursuant to the Chapter 12 of the 2015 Unconsolidated Laws of the State of New York, § 6416-B and to Chapter 64 of the 2015 Laws of New Jersey supplementing chapter 1 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of New Jersey, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey is now subject to the New York Freedom of Information Law (Public Officers Law, Art. 6, Section 84, et seq.) ("FOIL") and the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (C.47:1A-1, et seq.) ("OPRA").



Both FOIL and OPRA set limited periods for response to requests for information and permit court enforcement of public information requests which are unreasonably delayed or denied including potential for the provision of attorney's fees and damages. The OPRA statute also provides for civil penalty to be assessed against any "public official, officer, employee or custodian who knowingly and willfully violates P.L. 1963, c. 73 (C. 47:1A-1 et seq.), as amended and supplemented, and is found to have unreasonably denied access under the totality of the circumstances." N.J. Stat. § 47:1A-11. Civil penalties range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per violation assessed.

I agree in advance to pay reasonable copying fees as provided for by applicable law.



JOSEPH P. DUNNE

Joe Dunne enjoyed a distinguished 32-year career in the New York City Police Department, rising through the ranks from patrol officer to second in command of the 50,000 member agency. He joined the NYPD in 1969 and worked in a variety of operational and administrative assignments while gaining promotion to Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain. He has extensive experience in the patrol function of policing as well as detective and internal affairs investigations. From 1989 to 1999 he served in several senior command positions gaining a reputation for innovative crime fighting strategies and excellent community relations. In 1999, then Chief Dunne was promoted to Chief of Department, the highest ranking uniform position in the NYPD, in command of the five NYPD enforcement Bureaus – Patrol Services, Detectives, Organized Crime Control, Housing and Transit. He was responsible for coordinating the crime control strategy known as “CompStat” which tracks and analyzes crime incidents via computerized statistics. CompStat was the driving force behind NYPD’s remarkable crime reduction efforts beginning in the 1990’s. Chief Dunne also planned and coordinated several major events during his tenure as Chief of Department including the New Year’s Eve Millennium Celebration, Y2K Disaster Preparedness, Operation Sail 2000 and the United Nations Millennium Summit.

In the Fall of 2000, he was appointed First Deputy Police Commissioner. In this position, Commissioner Dunne was the chief administrative official in the NYPD in charge of budgetary, management and personnel functions of the department. He also supervised the discipline system and represented the Department in labor matters. He was the advisor to the Police Commissioner and was acting Police Commissioner in his absence.

Commissioner Dunne responded to the scene and was closely involved in the emergency response to the terrorist attack at the World Trade Center on 9/11 and in the recovery efforts that followed.

Upon his retirement in 2002, Mr. Dunne joined UBS Wealth Management as a Managing Director heading Security Services in the Americas and Puerto Rico for this world leading financial services and international banking firm. Under his leadership UBS upgraded home office and branch physical security systems and streamlined the background screening process. He retired in April of 2009 after seven years of service. He currently works as a consultant to City and State agencies in security related matters. Most recently he has led consultant activities on behalf of the City of New York, Business Integrity Commission and the Bergen County New Jersey Prosecutors Office.

Mr. Dunne holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from St. Francis College and is a graduate of the Columbia University Police Management Institute. He also has an Honorary Doctor of Civil Law Degree from Saint Francis College, Brooklyn, New York. He lives in New York City and has been married for more than 37 years with two adult children and three grand-children.




