Dear Records Access Officer:

Under the provisions of the New York Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, I hereby request electronic records of customer wait times at airport security screening checkpoints for John F. Kennedy International Airport, Newark Liberty International Airport, and LaGuardia Airport from 2004 to the present.

For each airport, checkpoint, day and hour, I request the average and maximum wait time in minutes. If information is not available at this granularity, I request the most detailed information available, for example, daily maximums and averages by airport and checkpoint type.

Under §87(5)(a) of the Public Officers Law, I specifically request these records in a common machine-readable format such as delimited text, Excel spreadsheets, or database files.

If my request appears to be extensive or fails to reasonably describe the records, please contact me in writing or by phone at (212) 416-2250.

Please provide these records by email to martin.burch@wsj.com. If the requested records cannot be emailed to me due to the volume of records identified in response to my request, please advise me of the actual cost of copying all records onto CD or DVD.

If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in writing and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed.
