My company is the auto insurance carrier for a vehicle that collided with another vehicle on Mon Jun 6, 2016, at approx. 10:15 AM, at passenger pickup in front of Term C at Newark Liberty Airport. Our Insured vehicle (2014 Dodge Ram Pickup Truck 3500 4 door 8 foot bed dually black NJ P44GBW) was parked at the curb. Other vehicle (2012 Audi Q5 4 door SUV gray NJ J65CFF) was stopped in the second lane, to the left of the Dodge truck. The male driver of the Audi SUV was loading luggage into the rear as a female passenger opened the rear passenger side door of the Audi SUV and entered the vehicle.
