I have cell phone photos of the incident. The tag on the truck N.J. XCT-K3Y. The driver of the truck did not present any documents was aggressive, uncooperative and did not seem to have command of our language or an understanding of our traffic laws. There were other occupants in the van however I could not see how many were present. The driver fled the scene. I notified the NYPD and was told to report to the station to give a statement. See the detailed police report that is enclosed. I question their intentions on entering N.Y.C and their immigration status. This individual caused thousands of dollars in damage to my car and injured my family.

. Your agency has access to the data from the traffic and security cameras in that area. I am requesting that someone from your agency view the crime and contact me. The owner of the truck and the driver should be investigated and prosecuted. I will present as a court witness.
